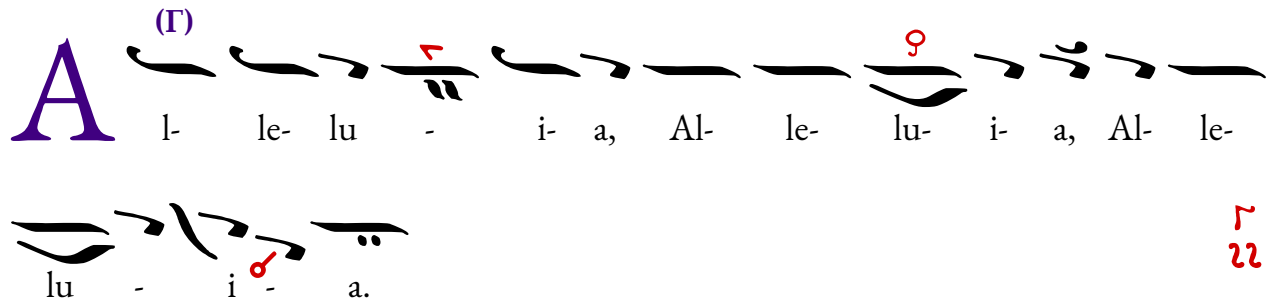

v2. Learn justice, inhabitants of the earth.

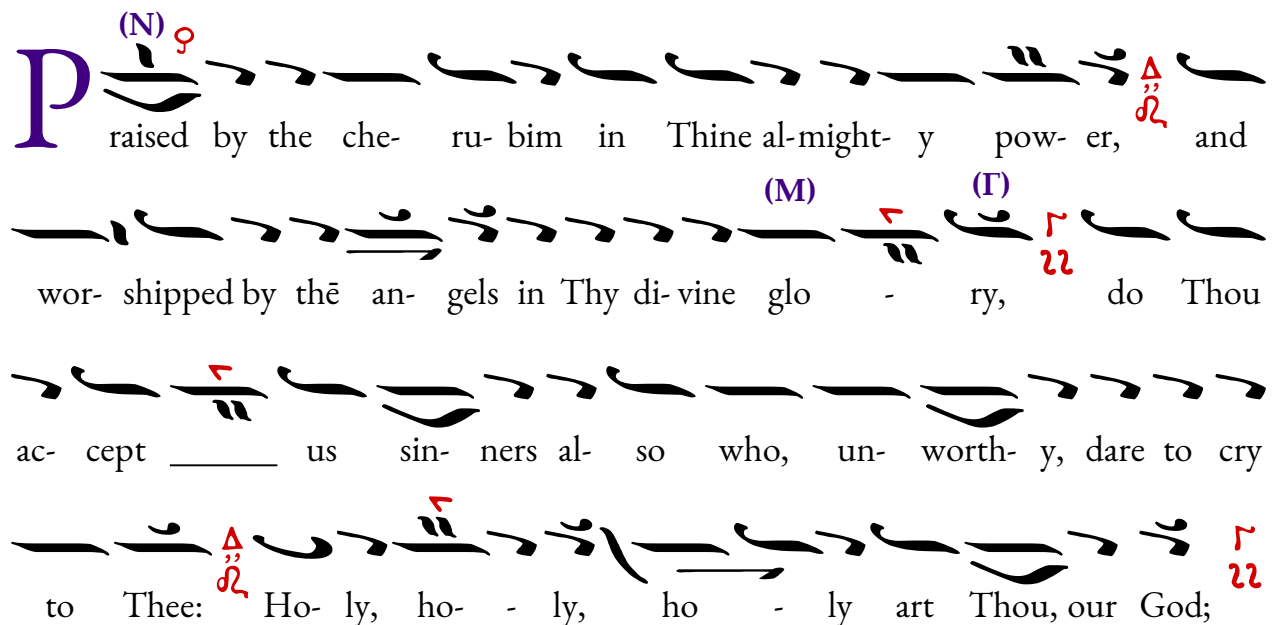
v3. Jealousy will seize an untaught people, and now fire devours their adversaries.
